When the Waters are Troubled; Step in by Faith.

It is the moving of the water that generates power and results.

We say, Lord send a revival and let it start with me, then we sit down on God and wait for a special invitation, service, or move of God, before we can get motivated to act. Teach me, Lord, to be a worshipper not a whisperer. Help me to trouble the waters enough to bring life to my soul. Lord, help me to be unsatisfied with a mediocre, half-hearted, approach to God. Help me to reverence your sanctuary as you commanded in Leviticus 19:30. Make me truly hungry for revival. Teach me to pray and invite revival in our midst.

Stop my own unbelief from hindering what you desire to do through me. It's very easy to move with the water, to move along without a vision, but it takes discipline to change direction against the current of the world. Help me to know you, Lord, and to hear your voice as you lead me into all truth. Remind me of your faithfulness. Help me choose to go against the current of the world. Teach me to trust you implicitly even when I don't understand where you are leading me to or why.
