## Sometimes, His Answer is to Wait

“Hear O Israel; the Lord our God is one Lord: and thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thine might” (Deuteronomy 6:4-5).

“Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the Lord your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee. And thou shalt do that which is right and good in the sight of the Lord” (Deuteronomy 6:17-18).

Even when his answer is to wait, we are to keep trusting that we serve a faithful God who cares about us. So many times we get ahead of God’s plan when we don’t realize that he has already heard our plea. If we’ll learn to trust him and his provision, we’ll reap more than we ever thought possible. When the Israelites had to depend on the Lord for their daily provision it wasn’t easy to trust that the manna would be waiting for them every morning, yet it was, and it was sufficient. If they gathered more than necessary, it would spoil every time.

We may not gather manna from heaven, but it’s our natural tendency to store up against the day when there is not enough food; God desires us to trust him.

According to Strong’s Concordance, ministry simply means “to serve” All Christians seek to find areas of ministry in which they are most suited to work. Some people are called to more visible areas to serve others, such as music, preaching, singing; while all people are called to be prayer warriors and worshipers.

One of the most important things to remember about ministry that keeps going through my mind: no matter where we’re called to serve, we must do our best. When you have done all that is within your power to do, and it seems that God is not hearing you when you pray; take heart because I happen to know that God is faithful. If he isn’t answering your prayers it may be because he is preparing your answer in his will. Keep your attentions on Jesus. We have to remember that we must put him first in our lives. Every part of me belongs to Jesus. He desires all of me, not leftovers Sometimes we can become so involved in working our ministry, that it becomes our focus and therefore it becomes a hindrance to us.

We replace our worship with our ministry, and both suffer from neglect. Our disorganized priorities block our view of the incredible world that we live in. The Lord teaches us to wait on him. When ministry blocks our view to the glory of God, we need to step aside and allow God to have his rightful place in our lives. We shall reap the harvest if we faint not. Keep God first in your life.

“And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh” (Jude 1:22-23).

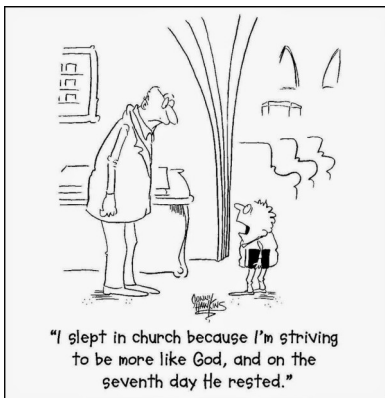
