Waiting on God is Always Worth It

Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh (James 5:7-8).

Have you ever felt that the Lord has forgotten about your needs, or that he isn't listening when you call? I have. It's not that I don't have enough faith to believe God—we all have a measure of faith—it's that I get impatient when I have to wait. When the pressure is on, we want to get problems solved immediately. It's hard to wait on God.

Sometimes we are our greatest obstacle: when we allow our doubt to dictate the choices we make, instead of standing on the Word of God. Remember, there is no failure in Jesus. We must learn to believe that we are precious in his sight and he loves us. Because he loves us, he desires to give us great gifts. The world and all of it's riches are within our grasp, but we must reach for it and believe that we can have it. Trust God. How big is your God? Are you trying to contain him in a box, or are you untying his hands to allow him to bless you as much as he desires.

The cherry tree grew tall, but it also established a deep root system which found it's way to a source of nourishment. As a result, it bore fruit. When we feed on the Word, the Bread of Life, and "thirst after righteousness" allowing the Holy Spirit to wash over us in praise, we will begin to flourish. Through prayer and obedience to the Lord, we will reap a harvest of souls. Water is an essential part of the diet, and when we yield ourselves to God's Spirit and reach out to receive all that the Lord has for us, we'll not be able to contain the blessing that the Lord will pour out on us.

Don't settle for yesterday's blessings. His blessings are immediate. Prayer completes a well balanced spiritual diet. If you desire to do God's will, pray and he will lead you into all Truth. Having the fullness of God working in our lives is worth the wait. -gm


