A Message to Men

As a dad I have decided that it's my job to call my sons into manhood. To teach them what it means to be a man and prepare them for that journey. What is biblical manhood, or how does God define manhood? After searching scripture and much research in other non-Biblical sources I found seven characteristics that I believe can be used to give us a definition of manhood.

The best definition I have found is from “The Resolution” by the Kendrick brothers: “A man is an adult male who accepts his masculinity, speaks and acts with maturity, embraces responsibility, functions independently, can lead a family faithfully, and recognizes his accountability as an image bearer of God.”

- 1) **A man accepts his Masculinity. 1Co 16:13** David told Solomon to be strong and show yourself a man. This wasn't just physical strength. It meant moral, mental, social and spiritual strength. This way, when things get hard and they will, you will have the strength and character to face adversity and not quit. Otherwise, we become passive cowards that will not stand up for anything.
- 2) **A man speaks and acts with Maturity. 1Co 13:11** We do not need Peter Pan Christian Men who never want to grow up. Too many men want the freedoms, rewards and privileges of manhood with the responsibilities of boyhood.
- 3) **A man embraces Responsibility. Gen 1:26 and 2:15** We must fully embrace our God given responsibilities to our families, our jobs, the church and to each other. We must model this, live this and teach this.
- 4) **A man functions Independently. Genesis 2:24** While God does not want us to be alone, he doesn't expect us to need to have someone take care of us. Men should be fountains, not drains.
- 5) **A man can Lead a Family Faithfully. 1Timothy 3:4-5** If you are single you should be learning and locking down the character qualities necessary for marriage and parenting. If you're married you should be living them. If you are raising a son you should be teaching him, by word and action, the responsibilities of a husband and father.
- 6) **A man Recognizes his Accountability. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14** All of life's privileges, blessing and freedoms that come with responsibility also come with the counterweight of Accountability. Having no accountability always leads to irresponsibility. We are accountable to God. We can prepare for that by being accountable to each other.
- 7) **A man is an Image Bearer of God. Genesis 1:26 1Co 11:7** Alone among creation, man bears the image of God. Therefore, in all of our actions, choices, words and behaviors we need to represent him well. This is humbling, but a great honor and privilege.

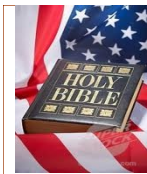

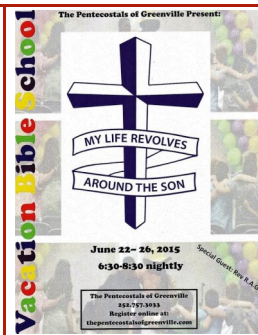
What's Happening at POG?
