Abiding Under the Shadow

“O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may rejoice and be glad all our days. Make us glad according to the days wherein thou hast afflicted us, and the years wherein we have seen evil” (Psalm 90:14-15).

“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust” (Psalm 91:1-2).

We have been in a season of testing in the last few months, now the Lord is preparing us for a new work that he desires to perform in us. It used to be that we couldn't wait to get into his presence; now, too often, we push aside the Lord for work, the empty social gatherings, or our own entertainment. How long will we limit God? He can only prosper us as our soul prospers.

So, we wonder why we stay so stressed out with fear and anxiety as we go through the redundant routines of daily living. It is because we have forgotten that we need God! I can't do this on my own, but if I'm called to bear that cross, I will make it because I'm learning how to abide under the shadow.” I know that I need God to direct my steps. When I move through my day, I want to know that he has gone before me to make the way.

He promised to set before me an open door. By the way, you don't have to preach on the job for people to know that you're a Christian; they'll know that you're a Christian by the way you live your life. If the Lord has placed his anointing on you; they will know. gm

Willie's Korner **A Famous Opera (posted in Complete)** Composer Giacomo Puccini wrote a number of famous operas. In 1922 he was suddenly stricken by cancer while working on his last opera, *Turbaned*, which many now consider his best. Composer Puccini said to his students, "If I don't finish *Turbaned*, I want you to finish it for me." Shortly afterward he died.

Puccini students studied the opera carefully and soon completed it. In 1926 the world premiere of *Turbaned* was performed in Milan with Puccini favorite student, Arturo Toscanini, directing. Everything went beautifully until the opera reached the point where Puccini had been forced to put down his pen. Tears ran down Toscanini face. He stopped the music, put down his baton, turned to the audience, and cried out, "Thus far the Master wrote, but he died."

A vast silence filled the opera house. Then Toscanini picked up the baton again, smiled through his tears, and exclaimed, "But the disciples finished his work."

When *Turbaned* ended, the audience broke into thunderous applause. No one at the premiere ever forgot that moment.

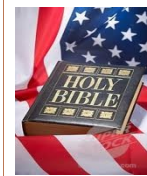
