## Trust in God at All Times, Even Through Change

*Focus for today:* Changing directions in life doesn't always have to cause defeat if we will remember that the Lord allows change to empower us to be fit for his use.)

“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth” (3 John 2).

“Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast unto the end; While it is said, “To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation. ... So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief” (Hebrews 3:12-15,19).

Change brings challenges, but we must embrace change and continually be thankful even when our hope is bleak.
