He Could have Walked Away: but He Didn't

“What can wash away my sin, nothing but the blood of Jesus, what can make me whole again, nothing but the blood of Jesus. O, precious is the flow, that makes me white as snow, no other fount I know, Nothing but the blood of Jesus.”

If you were called to sacrifice yourself for your family, you may consider doing it because you have a great love for them. If you were called on to sacrifice yourself for your friends, you could possibly feel a sense of duty to do everything in your power to help your friends, after all, they would do the same thing for you, right?

That wasn't the case when Jesus went to Calvary. He had a friend who denied him three times. Peter repented of his terrible sin and later became the rock on which the church was built. A trusted disciple, Judas Iscariot, betrayed Jesus with a kiss and 30 pieces of silver. The disciples were frightened and upset that he was being crucified, but they felt powerless to stop the crowds. This was one area where they needed to trust God more than ever. They knew who Jesus was, and is, and still the time had come for the ultimate price to be paid.

Today, we are truly blessed beyond measure. We have food, clothing, and shelter. We throw away more leftovers than some people have to survive. Have we forgotten what it was like before we found Jesus? The Laodicean church said “I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing;” but the Lord told us that the Laodicean church was “wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked” (Revelation 3:17).

It's a matter of perception. It is time to repent of our complacency. It is time to focus on the things that really matter: worshiping Jesus Christ. Jesus could have walked away from his purpose, and rightly so, considering the hate that the people had towards him. Satan thought that he had won the greatest war of all time. Instead, he became a pawn in Jesus' hands—the avenue by which Jesus could obtain the key to death, hell, and the grave Satan will always be under the dominion of Jesus Christ, and it thrilled him to think that he had destroyed Jesus; but, he never bargained for the victory that would release his victims from all of their sins—our salvation.

Jesus said, “I counsel thee to buy me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eye salve, that thou mayest see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent” (Revelation 3:18, 19).
