Hosanna to the King– Palm Sunday

Today is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; and Luke 19: 29-40 gives the account of Jesus riding into Jerusalem as people laid down palm branches before him. It was a gesture of honor, then, one week later they crucified him. Jesus became our Salvation. On this Sunday before Easter, we are blessed that you took the time out of your schedule to be here to worship with us. There is great joy in having the freedom to worship: not every nation has that freedom. When I think about why we can worship freely, the scriptures remind us of who we can trust for everything:

*Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits,
Who forgiveth all thine iniquities, who healeth all thy diseases,
Who redeemeth thy life from destruction,
Who crowneth thee with loving-kindness and tender mercies,
Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things,
so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's....
The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger,
and plenteous in mercy, (Psalm 103:2-5; 103:8).*

The Lord is everything to me. When I think about how he has guided me through all the rough spots in my life, all I can say is thank you, Lord. I have learned after many failures to keep moving forward with his plan for my life. I don't always see how it'll work out, nor do I understand all of the fine details of his operation on my behalf, but just the same, I know that he is doing all things great in my life for my own good.
