## Will You Leave With Empty Vessels?

“Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up. And their nobles have sent their little ones to the waters; they came to the pits, and found no water; they returned with their vessels empty: they were ashamed and confounded, and covered their heads” (Jeremiah 14:2-3).

The little ones were sent to get water but when they couldn't find water they had no choice but to come back empty-handed and they were so ashamed that they covered their heads. 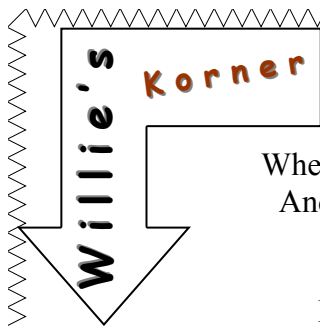
