## One of God's Greatest Designs: The Human Mind

“Whither shall I go from thy spirit? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence?  
If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell,  
behold, thou art there.

If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;  
Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about  
me. Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the  
darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.

I can barely remember not having this technology at my fingertips. But in our quest for modern convenience, let's not forget that these material gadgets will eventually pass away. What will we have to show for our time and energy? Let's not allow Satan to lure us into his “web,” (pardon the pun) rather, let's do everything to the glory of God and to the edifying of the body of Christ. This will make us free to worship. —gm

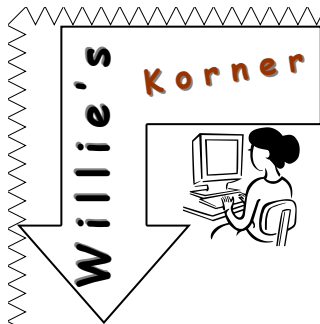

computer

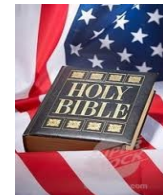
