“Thou whom I have taken from the ends of the earth, and called thee from the chief men thereof, and said unto thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish” (Isaiah 40:9-10)

We have the Lord's promise that he will take care of us when the enemy tries to overpower us, so we have nothing to fear if we are serving Jesus. Sometimes, we may forget who we are serving—we may even look at the waves and the roaring seas of our trials and turn away from Jesus, temporarily. But today, we can start afresh serving the Lord with our whole heart.
