"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable" (Psalm 145:3). I stand in awe of a God who cares about me. 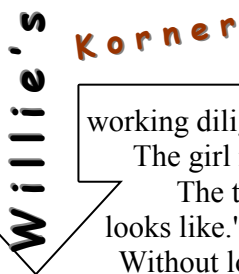
