He Offers to Protect and Guide Us

Psalm 91 was one of my Mother’s favorite passages of scripture Just as the Lord protects and guides us through life, so our mothers have provided the nurturing and protection needed to learn how to survive. To honor Mothers, today, I share my understanding of the scriptures:

9 Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. [We can choose to make our homes a sanctuary or a prison: we need to choose wisely for it’s our actions at home that will determine whether or not, “evil befalls us.”]

11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. [The angels are on a mission to protect us and lead us into all truth]

12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. [The angels will literally pick you up with their hands as the Lord commands and carry you to a safe place.]

13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. [You may be fearful, but you have authority in the Name of Jesus Christ; Use it to overcome].

14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. [Jesus knows your name.]

15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. [The Lord has already promised that we wouldn’t have to face trouble alone. He tells us that he will be with us in trouble to deliver us.]

16 With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation. The key to obtaining a satisfying long life is to trust God and to find salvation. Once we discover the love of Jesus, we need to learn to saturate ourselves in his love and put our faith and trust in him. Everything that concerns us, concerns him. For many children, today, could be difficult.

Whether your mother is living or not, today is the day we set aside to honor her.

When you think about her, maybe you could reminisce about the times that only you two shared alone.

Thank you for coming today. Let’s enter into his presence with thanksgiving for he has done marvelous things. May the Lord richly bless you today. –gm
