What are the most significant attributes of a good father?

- 6. A man of God is the spiritual leader in his home. When it's time for prayer, he encourages his family to pray; when it's time for church he makes sure that everyone gets to church on time. When his family enters into the sanctuary they know that it's time to worship the Lord in spirit and in truth and they aren't ashamed to be used by God in a miraculous way, because they have been led by the man of God.
