“Obey My Voice, and I will be your God”

When was the last time that I heard his voice midst all of the confusion of the world? I must check my own spirit at times, and ask if I'm in tune with the Spirit. Is my conversation with Jesus Christ communication or confusion? These important questions must be asked by every believer, lest we lose our way through the maze of daily living. There will never be enough time to accomplish all that we desire to do in life, but if we'll only listen to the plan that the Lord has for us, we can accomplish every purpose that he has designed for our good, and he'll make a way for us to fulfill his will.

No matter how often we insist that the Lord isn't bringing our answer quick enough: it will be well with us, if we'll only learn how to stop and abide in his presence. The time we spend in his presence will heal our anxiety, cast out the spirit of fear, and teach us how to trust in the One God who is “able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we could ask or think.” The Israelites only had to obey the voice of the Lord to have a great and prosperous life. They already had the blessing of the Lord, if they made the right choices. On the other hand, the end results of disobedience to God, is moving backwards away from the Lord's presence, where it is cold and dark without the light of God to illuminate our path.

²⁷**Therefore thou shalt speak all these words unto them, but they will not hearken to thee: thou shalt also call unto them; but they will not answer thee.** The Lord has always desired to speak with his children, and build a relationship with them, but we must choose to listen to what he tells us: Jerusalem refused to listen to God, and there were severe consequences to pay, because judgment fell on the land.

²⁸**But thou shalt say unto them, This is a nation that obeyeth not the voice of the Lord their God, nor receiveth correction: truth is perished, and is cut off from their mouth”** (Jeremiah 7:27-28).

The Lord already knew what Jerusalem's response would be to his call. Not only did the people disobey the Lord, they became so entangled with the world, that they couldn't hear God calling them any more. We must wake up before we lose out with God. It is so easy to get too busy to pray. It is so easy to make excuses to skip Bible reading just this one time. Once we begin to miss services, it becomes easier to miss, a prayer meeting, or a Sunday night, or a Wednesday night service. We justify our actions and live with the consequences that are sure to come when you begin to starve your soul for a few selfish moments of worldly pleasure. -gm
