## There's Power in Believing the Promise

<sup>1</sup>Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. <sup>2</sup> For by it the elders obtained a good report. <sup>3</sup>Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

What kind of faith do we need? We all have faith as a grain of mustard seed. Is this sufficient? How much or little faith you have doesn't matter as much as what you do with the measure of faith you have been given. It is when you begin to feed your faith with the bread of life, and quench your thirst with the living waters that flow from your worship, that you begin to reap the promises of God.

We must strive for "now faith" because in some situations waiting for our faith to kick in sometime next month, would be too late. If you are going to survive in the realm of the supernatural, then you must not be afraid to call on the Name of Jesus Christ. Once you have called on him to intervene, then stand by faith and believe. I know that's easier said than done sometimes, but we must learn **through faith**. Through faith is the kind of faith that no matter what circumstances you face, you keep going through it until the Lord delivers his promise. You don't sit around and wait, whining about your dire circumstances, you actively seek God's face through prayer and supplication, and keep on praising him no matter how the outcome looks. Faith is the victorious shout you give, even when your flesh feels like doubting.

<sup>6</sup> But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. One thing I have learned through many years of trials: God always comes through and he desires that we be prosperous and in good health. Sometimes it seems that our worlds are turned upside down. It is during those times that we grow spiritually, and when he doesn't answer our petitions immediately, he has something better waiting for us.

<sup>8</sup> By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. <sup>9</sup> By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: <sup>10</sup>For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God. He didn't wait for it to fall in his lap; he looked for the promise to come. We must hold on to our promise, by faith, and we will receive it. There's power in believing: Keep believing! (scriptures selected from Hebrews 11) -gm


