One of God's Greatest Designs: The Human Mind

“Whither shall I go from thy spirit? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

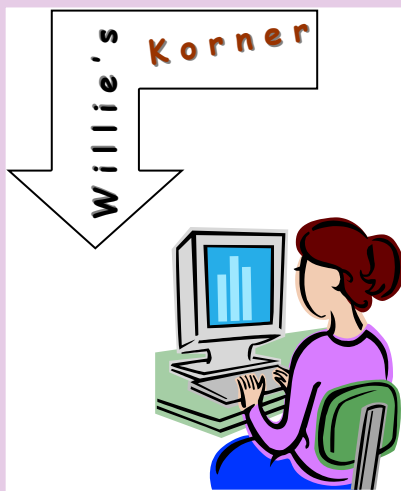
