## Don't Delay: Prepare for Eternity

"Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13-14).

It's often much easier to say that you've put the past behind you, than it is to actually develop a trusting relationship with Jesus Christ and put the past behind. While we've had great success in soul winning in the past, this isn't the time to sit back and be at ease because everyday someone has a last opportunity to follow Jesus Christ. Knowing that should disturb us greatly, but I fear that we've grown used to our successes, and maybe we think that we've done enough. It's just easier in our busy world to let someone else go after people: someone who is more dynamic, talented, respected, educated, whatever. Our perspective is all wrong.

When we hesitate to accept the blessings of God, it's the same as rejecting the blessings of God. WE can't push aside our salvation or wait for a more convenient time, because we aren't promised tomorrow! Life is a vapor and death is sure; hell is a real place.

When I give an account to the Lord on Judgment Day, I want to hear "Well done thou good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of the Lord." If I don't reach out, I will face the ones who were lost because I was too busy. They'll ask me why I didn't tell them. Lord, I need you in my life and I want to be an effective soul winner. Sometimes I have good intentions and call. Help me not to be discouraged but rather continue to ask people and encourage them to take a hold of this salvation that was purchased with your precious blood. Help those who delay and draw them. 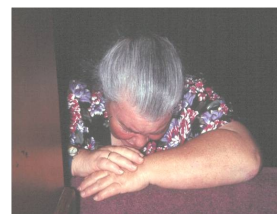
