## We Triumph When Praise is on the Front Lines

“...Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude: for the battle is not yours, but God’s” (2 Chronicles 20:15).

“And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the Lord, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the Lord; for his mercy endureth forever” (2 Chronicles 20:21).

Jehoshaphat, King of Judah, could have been distressed when the news came that the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them other beside the Ammonites, were going to do battle with them, because their armies were great and no match for his people. Instead, the King called for a solemn fast. The people fasted, prayed, and sought God to direct their steps for the right course of action. Their faith and obedience paid off, because the enemy wasn’t expecting worship; the enemy became confused and turned on each other, and it took three days to gather the spoil.

When we put praise on the front lines, we will always triumph. Praise and Prayer go hand in hand. The Lord inhabits our praises, and he says for us to ask and it shall be done. We can’t lose when we follow his plan for our lives. Following the plan doesn’t mean that we’ll not face any hardships, because Satan desires to have us. When we offer up praise and worship, we are a weapon that he can’t defeat. He knows that if we begin to understand our authority in Jesus Christ, that nothing will be out of our grasp; if we ask, so Satan tries to steal the joy from our heart.

The word of God is powerful and if we have the word in our heart, we will have joy. Joy is our strength, without it, we open ourselves up for attack from the adversary. If we give up our joy, we will become weak and defeated.

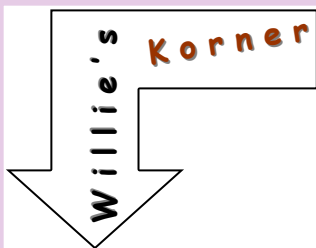
