The Best is Yet to Come!

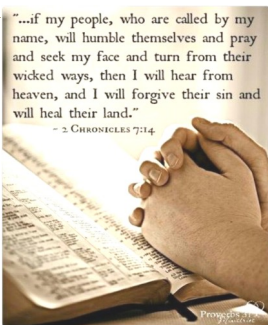
