## The Power of Prayer and Now Faith!



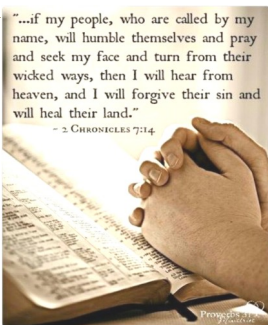
