His Presence, His Plan, His Power

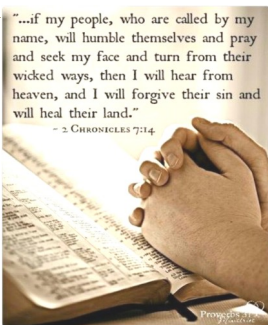

The Lord has given us light to bring us out of darkness. It will guide us into all truth, if we'll learn how to take the time to just BE in his presence. 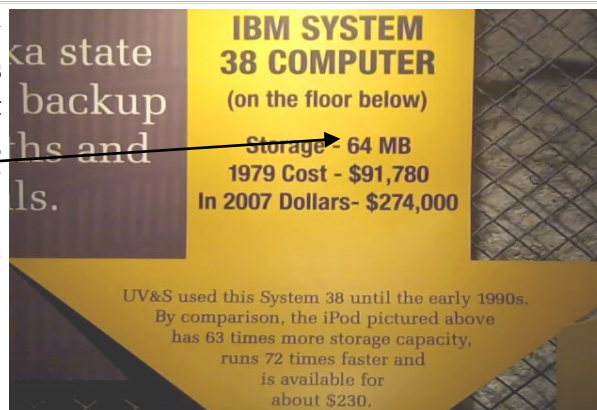
