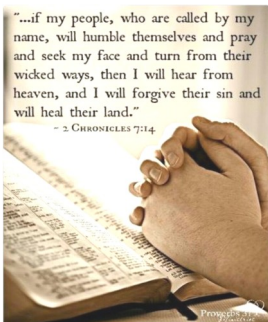
During the next week, most of us will be out of our regular routines as family members may be visiting or we'll be traveling to spend Christmas with them. Sometimes we see extended family that we barely know and they may not be living for God. The Lord has given us an opportunity to represent him to our families. There are many ways that we can represent Christ without teaching a Bible study (although if they open the door to one, go for it.). We can represent Christ through our actions, our attitudes, and our manners.

If you are Holy Ghost filled you will already be separated from your family if they aren't living for God. They may recognize the change in you more than you recognize the change in yourself. The Lord allows them to see the light that he has placed in you because it is the light that will draw them to himself. Sometimes family may feel slightly uncomfortable around you because you are so changed from the person you used to be. It is your responsibility to still be a family member and love them unconditionally. You can't change them: so don't condemn them. We are commissioned to let our light shine before men; but remember, it is God who will do a work in their lives in his time.

When you communicate with your unsaved loved ones, be as nonjudgmental as possible; however, do not compromise what the Lord has saved you from to join in activities that are sin. Always maintain your relationship with God, because it could determine if your family will make a move for God. If they don't believe that you are sincere about serving God, your actions may decide if they will reject or accept salvation. If they see that you are unchanged they may not see a need to turn to the Lord with all of their heart, soul, mind, and strength. Don't hide your light under a bushel, nor be ashamed of this gospel. It is a glorious blessing to have Jesus working in our lives. We have been called out of darkness and into his marvelous light. We have been redeemed; we are at peace with ourselves and with everyone.

Finally, when the last present has been unwrapped and you have said your last goodbye; think about how blessed that you feel because you know him. He promises that if we'll abide in his word and his word abides in us that we can ask what we will and it shall be done. There is hope for our families today and we have been given the most precious gift that we can give to them: our time.
