When He said, “It’s not here” my head hung in shame.

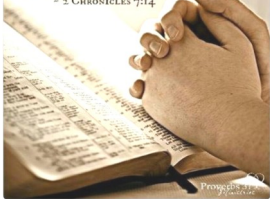
The people whose names had been written with love
