The Privilege of Prayer

"Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called a house of prayer for all people. Sometimes it may seem that you aren't getting the results that you'd like when you pour out your heart day after day. It may look like the enemy has won: but don't quit! Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

He tells us that he will not forget us because we are carved into the palms of his hands, which is an eternal reminder that we are his children. In the hymn "What a Friend we Have in Jesus" the songwriter tells us that it is a privilege to carry everything to God in prayer. He writes, "Oh, what peace we often forfeit/ Oh, what needless pain we bear/ all because we do not carry/ everything to God in prayer." The Lord is ready to help us, if we will allow him to take control of our situations. Let's remember how blessed we are to be able to call on the Name of Jesus, and to have him care about us.
