Have you Lost Faith in Your Prayers?

“And Adam knew his wife again; and she bare a son, and called his name Seth: For God, said she, hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, who Cain slew. And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the Lord” (Genesis 4:25-26). 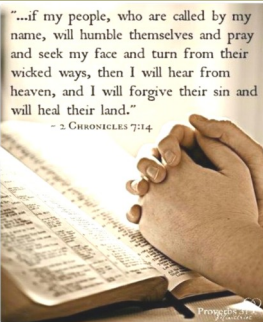

His blessings are to be received as precious jewels not as hand-me-downs that happened to fall on us one day. The ways and Spirit of God are not to be thrown by the wayside to be rejected. If we are willing vessels who desire to be used by God, and we come to the Lord with a clean heart and a right spirit, he promises to pour out his spirit. 4. **Push-a-ways:** Push away from the table in order to fast and pray. The Lord delights in our worship. If you will delight in the Lord, you will be spiritually fit for the master’s use.
