Bring Forth Fruit that Remains

“Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain; that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you” (John 15:16).

We have been ordained to bring forth fruit that will remain, then the Lord promises us that whatever we ask in Jesus’ Name will be given to us. Every statement that he makes in John Chapter 15, expresses to us what is required of us if we want to see our prayers answered. One of the strongest promises that we have, is when we are told to abide in Him.

“Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me” (John 15:4). Without prayer, our communion with God is severely limited, because it’s through prayer, that we touch God and get answers that could make the difference between eternal life and death in someone’s life.

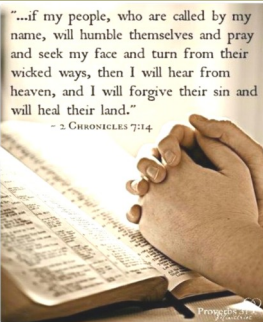
“I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit; for without me ye can do nothing” (John 15:5).
