Let’s not forget that God has all the power, and if we are walking in his light, we will also be able to shine like “as city set on a hill.” gm

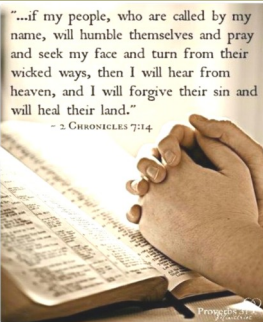
Words of Comfort
