For we breathe each breath of life—today.

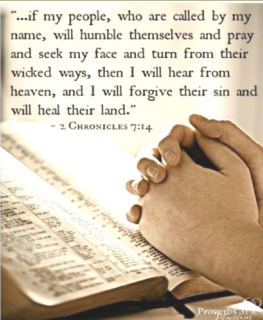
We drink from the fountain of living water;
