Restore unto me Salvation

Let me start off with the bad news: we are all born with the curse of sin "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" (Rom. 3:23). Sin is described in the Bible as transgression of the law of God (I John 3:4) and rebellion against God (Joshua 1:18). Not only that, but because we have inherited a sinful nature from Adam, we commit individual, personal sins every day which might range from a seemingly innocent untruth to cursing to murder. We are sinners not because we sin; we sin because we are sinners.

Even great men of God recorded in the word of God have fallen into sin. David was a murderer and adulterer. Paul was a persecutor of many Christians. Peter was a denier of Christ. And we are not exempt nor incapable of falling into sin. But there's more to that: "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" (Romans 5:12) "For the wages of sin is death...." (Romans 6:23—I'll come back to the rest of this verse in a minute!) And you ask yourself, who can be saved, even I?

And now the great news: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16) That "whosoever" includes YOU and everyone else! Jesus came to save you, to restore salvation in your life, no matter what you've done. Even if you have drifted out of church, He can restore you! His grace is unlimited, and His mercies are new every morning.

Now back to Romans 6:23: "....BUT the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." In the Hebrew language, the name of Jesus is *Yeshua*, a combination of *Ya*, an abbreviation for *Yahweh*, the name of Israel's God, and *yasha*, meaning salvation. Hence the name Jesus: God's salvation. "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous." (Romans 5:19)

"For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost." Matthew 18:11 "For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them." Luke 9:56

"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." Luke 19:10

"For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." John 3:17

King David, knowing he had sinned greatly, repented greatly! We, knowing we are by nature sinners and have sinned, should repent also! Peter, on the day of Pentecost, not only told us to repent but "be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." (Acts 2:38) Jesus can restore your salvation today! I believe it.
