## Taking Time to Meditate

“Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.” (Psalm 19:14)

It's time to pause for a moment and meditate. I want you to think about these question: How often do you meditate? How often do you pause from your busy schedule just to think about your day? Your family? Your job? The direction your life is going? Or anything for



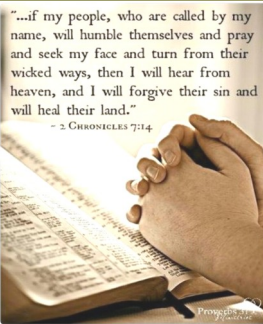
that matter. In today's world, standing still to meditate is becoming a lost craft. People talk about their feelings and their thoughts, but they don't really take time to think about what those feeling are or what those thoughts are.

Meditate means to think deeply or focus one's mind for a period of time. As a believer, our meditations can have an impact on our walk with God. In Psalm 19:14, David made this statement, “Let the words of my mouth, and meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.”

He asked God for two things. The first is that the words coming from his mouth be acceptable. In other words, he wanted his words to be pleasing to God. The second thing David asked for was that he wanted those deep times of focus on the matters of his heart to be pleasing to God. This Bible verse tells us that it's okay to pause and to meditate.

It's good in our meditations to take time to focus those thoughts in a manner that pleases God. So let's do it this week! Let's take time to pause and meditate on your life. Challenge yourself to think on the things that would be acceptable in God's sight.
