There's nothing too hard for God

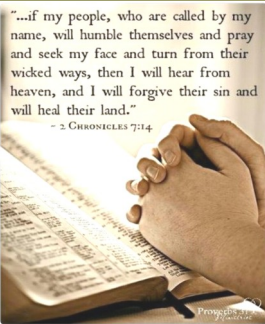
