When It's Hopeless, Hold on to Hope

"Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching of his understanding. He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk and not faint" (Isaiah 40:28-31).

So don't be discouraged; keep moving towards the light of His presence, and He will bring it to pass.

In the still of my night, I find him embracing me. I shall not fear the darkness. Although every sign tells me that it's hopeless, I still hold on to hope that he is sovereign and he has already answered my prayer even before I speak the problem in prayer. When I feel so impatient waiting for your promise, and I long for simplicity—life before schedules and deadlines—remind me that you are with me through the storm. Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever. Life is too short to spend lamenting over what might have been, by looking back. So for today, I want to say thanks for always being faithful.
