## Accepting God's Will for our Lives

(Focus for today: Changing directions in life doesn't always have to cause defeat if we will remember that the Lord allows change to empower us to be fit for his use.)

*"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."* (3 John 2)

*"Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast unto the end; While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation. ... So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief."* (Hebrews 3:12-15,19)

**Change brings challenges**, but we must embrace change and continually be thankful even when our hope is bleak. On the surface we look at our circumstances and we feel powerless to defend ourselves against the ones who would try to destroy us. Sometimes we may wonder if God truly cares about us, or if we are going to continually struggle while others breeze through life, unhindered. There is a place of restoration in Jesus that the world may never experience. **When we make decisions**, we'll decide with confidence if we pray. Yes, the world will still come in like a flood because there is sin in the world and we are God's people. But we can know that we can have confidence in God that no matter what challenges we face, God will never forsake us or leave us comfortless. *"My defense is of God, which saveth the upright in heart."* (Psalm 7:10) The enemy that tries to destroy you may be the one whom God will use to strength you. After you have overcome, then you will be stronger and more blessed than you ever thought possible.
