# The Power of Believing the Promise

What kind of faith do we need? We all have faith as a grain of mustard seed. Is this sufficient? How much or how little faith you have doesn't matter as much as what you do with the measure of faith you have been given. It is when you begin to feed your faith with the bread of life and quench your thirst with the living waters that flow from your worship, that you begin to reap the promises of God.

We must strive for "now faith" because in some situations, waiting for our faith to kick in sometime next month would be too late. through. Sometimes it seems that our worlds are turned upside down. It is during those times that we grow spiritually, and when He doesn't answer our petitions immediately, He has something better waiting for us.

"By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." (Hebrews 11:8-10) He didn't wait for it to fall in his lap; he looked for the promise to come. We must hold on to our promise, by faith, and we will receive it.
