Did Jesus, who was to be crucified, turn around and "crucify" Peter for his mistakes? No, Jesus forgave him after Peter had wept bitterly in repentance and then recognized that the church that he was to establish had to be built on a solid foundation: *"And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."* (Matthew 16:18)

It will take prayer to hold it all together when the storms come, but if we'll stay in the Word and lift each other up, we can build a foundation that'll stand no matter what storms may come our way.
