Praise and Worship: On the Front Lines

(I will be writing this month on the topic of praise and worship: their meaning, their significance in the word of God and our lives, and other aspects of these important means of honoring God!)

"And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the Lord, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the Lord; for his mercy endureth for ever. And when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten." (2 Chronicles 20:21-22)

Jehoshaphat, King of Judah, could have been distressed when the news came that the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them others beside the Ammonites, were going to do battle with them; these armies were great and no match for the people of Judah. Instead, the King called for a solemn fast, and the people fasted, prayed, and sought God to direct their steps for the right course of action. The spirit of the Lord came upon one named Jahaziel in the midst of the congregation, telling them the battle is not yours, but God's. Their faith and obedience paid off because the enemy wasn't expecting worship; the enemy became confused, turned on each other, and it took three days to gather the spoil.

We are in the midst of fierce spiritual battles today, outside *and* inside the church. Lions in the jungles use their loud roars to paralyze their victims for a moment, just enough to give them an advantage to successfully attack their prey. Just as Satan will come in like a roaring lion to prey upon you, we need to be vigilant in our prayers and in our praise and worship to drown out the noise of our adversaries! How confused Satan must be when, while we should be scared and hopeless, we are confident in our faith in God and praising God through our trials! When we put praise and prayer on the front lines of our battles in life, we will always triumph. Praise and prayer go hand in hand: the Lord inhabits our praises, and He says for us to ask and it shall be done. Oh, we're going to have battles and hardships in our lives, but when we offer up praise and worship, we are a weapon that Satan can't defeat.

Satan hates when we worship God. Worship is designed for God, and only God. Jesus knew this as the devil was tempting him in the wilderness. "If you'll just worship me, I'll give you all the kingdoms of this world." Jesus won the battle: "Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve." (Matthew 4:10). Also, the word of God and praising Him work together on the spiritual battlefield. "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword..." (Hebrews 4:12). "Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;" (Psalm 149:6). When we face the devil with praise <u>and</u> the word of God, Satan trembles as God gives us the victory.

Paul and Silas sang their way out of a jail. Seven priests blew their trumpets to bring down the walls of Jericho. David played the lyre to rid Saul of a harmful spirit. Isn't it time for you to put Satan in his place....which is under your feet? March out to the front of the battlefield, give praise to God and worship Him, and He will give you the victory!-wm/gm
