Hosanna to the King: Palm Sunday

Today is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. Matthew 21:1-11, Mark 11:1-11, and Luke 19: 29-40 give the account of Jesus riding into Jerusalem as people laid down palm branches before Him. It was a gesture of honor; then, one week later, they crucified Him. Jesus became our Salvation. On this Sunday before Easter, we are blessed that you took the time out of your schedule to be here to worship with us. There is great joy in having the freedom to worship; not every nation has that freedom. When I think about why we can worship freely, King David, writing in the Book of Psalms, reminds us of who we can trust for everything:

Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:
Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;
Who redeemeth thy life from destruction;
Who crowneth thee with loving-kindness and tender mercies;
Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things;
so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's....
The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger,
and plenteous in mercy. (Psalm 103:2-5; 103:8).

David was a man after God's own heart. "... He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will." (Acts 13:22) So, what attributes about David's worship got God's attention?

-David was remorseful in his worship. "O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall show forth thy praise. For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise." (Psalm 51:15-17) Even when David sinned, and knew he had sinned, he went humbly before God asking forgiveness, knowing God "desirest truth in the inward parts."

Scriptures to live by

"And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest." (Matthew 21:9)

- -David worshipped God no matter what was going on in his life. "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple." (Psalm 27:1, 3-4) Even while King Saul, for many years, was searching after David to kill him, David kept praising God, in his good times and his bad times.
- -David worshipped God with all his might. "...So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness. And it was so, that when they that bare the ark of the Lord had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings. And David danced before the Lord with all his might...So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the Lord with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet...and saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord..." (2 Samuel 6:12-16) Even when some of those around him thought he was overdoing it, David still continued to worship God with all that he had.

This Palm Sunday morning, let's be like David and welcome Jesus into our presence, no matter what our circumstances may be. Rejoice that He can answer your prayers, that He can save your soul. The Lord is truly worthy of all our praise! Hosanna to the King! Welcome to the Pentecostals of Greenville! -wm/gm
