Their Rejection, His Resurrection, Our Redemption

"Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:" (John 11:25)

The Lord went willingly with the soldiers although it hurt Him that Judas had betrayed Him. Jesus knew that it would require His life to purchase salvation for mankind, and yet He was still willing to pay that price. When the mob cried out "Crucify Him!" Jesus didn't argue but accepted the will of the Father. Everything looked bleak when Jesus was crucified. The soldiers pierced his side (although he was already dead) and the disciples laid him in a borrowed tomb. They had heard Him teach. They had



seen His miracles. But this was not a fairy tale, this was real: a cruel cross, nail prints, shed blood, death. Today we celebrate His life! Death couldn't keep Him! Resurrection!

Thankfully, the price for our redemption has already been paid. We are blessed because Jesus loved us enough to die for us, and we will reign with Him eternally! He made a way for us to have our inheritance of eternity because He carried His cross first to Calvary. Although our crosses may be difficult to carry through the crowds of today, as sometimes we may stumble and fall as we journey through this life, it's comforting to know that Jesus' cross bore so much more! He won't fail you in your darkest night. He'll be the light of hope that glimmers in a troubled life. When we see the cross that He bore for us, our crosses seems so much lighter after Calvary. We can make it! He cried out, "It is finished." But, is it really finished?

The price has been paid. It's up to us to decide if we will accept His generous offer of eternal life for our future and our commitment for the present. The Jews sincerely believed that Jesus was not the Messiah. They thought they were justified, so they killed their only salvation. They considered Christ a blasphemer. He was a healer. He was the cause of people assembling in the streets. He excited the crowds. He opened blind eyes and unstopped deaf ears. He raised the dead. The Jews couldn't accept Jesus for who He was because Jesus wasn't anything like they expected. How disillusioned they were to miss the greatest miracle of all: His unconditional love. Their rejection became our redemption. How blessed we are to have a Savior who loved us to death. He is alive today so we can live eternally tomorrow.
