Invite Someone to Church This Easter!

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen." (Matthew 28:19-20)

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15)

"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

It seems fitting that, when Jesus knew his ascension up to heaven was at hand and his time on earth with his disciples was ending, the last words they would hear would be of most importance. Jesus gives them (and us) "the great commission" which is simply to go share the Gospel (the Good News!) to all people, to be a witness on what God has done for you in your life. Many examples are recorded in the book of Acts of the apostles preaching the gospel to many people: Peter's sermon on the day of Pentecost, Peter and the Gentiles (Cornelius), Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch, to name a few. Paul was greatly used of God as a witness of Jesus Christ. Jesus speaks to Paul who was traveling to Damascus: "But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things, which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee:" (Acts 26:16) He became the New Testament's

greatest sharer of the Gospel and Jesus Christ, evangelizing in over 50 cities and starting up many new churches.

Easter is coming up in a couple of weeks (April

17th). We will be having two services that morning as we did last year: the first one at 8AM (full scale service without Sunday School or child care) and the other at 10AM (with Sunday School and child care). Of course there is an Easter egg hunt for the kids during Sunday School at 10AM! We also will have our Spanish services that weekend: 7Pm Saturday night in Greenville, and 6PM Sunday night in Greene County! Easter is probably the best time of the year to get people to come out to
