## One Life: Make it Count!

*“Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.” (James 4:14)*

(Some of this article is from Pastor Lappin’s “Developing a Winning Attitude” sermon last Wednesday night.)

**We have one chance** on this earth to live. After our last breath is taken, well, that’s it. Our lives, and what we’ve done in our lives, are forever and permanently written in the book of history AND in the Lamb’s Book of Life. You can’t go back and change it. This is the reality of it all.

**To the child of God,** death is not just the end of life but the beginning of eternal life, and that is great news. But to us who remain on this planetary mass speeding around in a vacuum called the universe, death is still an ugly thing. And we don’t know when it’s our time, or when it’s our loved ones’ time. We surely don’t know what tomorrow will bring.

**But if you’re reading this right now,** you have an opportunity to change your life! You can become what you believe! It will happen! Our faith in God is the key that unlocks the promises we have from God. Our attitude plays such an important part of how we think, how we react to life’s problems (opportunities)! John Maxwell, in his book *Today Matters*, gives us twelve disciplines (he calls the daily dozen) that can help create a new mindset for success in your life. Proverbs 23:7 tells us “For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he”:

**ATTITUDE:** I will choose and display the right attitudes daily.

**PRIORITIES:** I will determine and act upon important priorities daily.

**HEALTH:** I will know and follow healthy guidelines daily.

**FAMILY:** I will communicate with and care for my family daily.

**THINKING:** I will practice and develop good thinking daily.

**COMMITMENT:** I will make and keep proper commitments daily.

**FINANCES:** I will earn and properly manage finances fully.

**FAITH:** I will deepen and live out my faith daily.

**RELATIONSHIPS:** I will initiate and invest in solid relationships daily.

**GENEROSITY:** I will plan for and model generosity daily.

**VALUES:** I will embrace and practice good values daily.

**GROWTH:** I will desire and experience improvements daily.

**We also have an opportunity** today to give our life back to Jesus, if not done so yet. Acts 2:38. Yes, I want to be and do the best I can be while living, but when I face eternity, I want to know I’ll be living with Him in heaven: that’s the ultimate goal I have. And I want to help others reach that goal. And I want to do God’s will in my life. The old cliché, “Today is the first day of the rest of your life”, is not outdated but right on time for someone who wants that attitude of change in their life!
