The Pentecostals of Greenville... that's us! It's not the church down the road from us. It's not other churches in this city. It's not even other churches in our organization. It is us, a great Pentecostal church in Greenville, NC. In eastern NC. We are the hub of this region. In the book of Acts, the church was "born" on the Day of Pentecost, 50 days after the Passover, of which the Jewish holiday 'the Feast of Weeks'-also known as Pentecost-occurs. "And when the day of Pentecost was fully come...they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." (Acts 2:1,4,38) ***...is an Apostolic church....*** not a Methodist. Or Baptist. Or Catholic. ***Apostolic!*** 'Apostolic' relates to the twelve apostles that followed Jesus and their "acts" recorded in the book of Acts. The word 'apostle' comes from the Greek word 'apostolos' meaning 'sent one'.

...We are committed to exalt Jesus Christ... 'Committed': loyal and willing to give your time and energy to something you believe in. 'Exalt': to raise in rank, character, or status. To glorify, praise highly, and honor.

...to worship Him in Spirit and in Truth... 'Worship': to show honor or reverence or adoration to a divine being. "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth." (John 4:23-24) We worship God for who He is. "In Spirit..." means we have a passion for worshipping God, giving Him our all, not just through physical acts but through our hearts, our inner soul. "In Truth..." means we know *who* our God is and *what* He expects from us. "For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge." (Romans 10:2)


