What great things we can accomplish when we learn to spend time in His presence! The mountains in our lives that would try to separate us from Him will be removed. The Lord has given us light to bring us out of darkness. It will guide us into all truth, if we'll learn how to take the time to just BE in His presence. It is a great gift: the power of being.
