The Sin of Complacency

-Complacency: A feeling of calm satisfaction with your own abilities that prevents you from trying harder (Cambridge Dictionary)

-Complacency: A feeling of contentment or self-satisfaction, especially when coupled with an unawareness of danger, trouble, or controversy (American Heritage Dictionary)

-Complacency: A feeling of quiet pleasure or security, often while unaware of, or unconcerned with, unpleasant realities or harmful possibilities; self-satisfaction; smugness (Random House)

But we are the church! We are God's people. We are excluded from complacency, right?

The Laodicea church, for example. We are just cruising along. We've got money. We have nice possessions. We have a nice church building. We have nice services. We have a good number of people every Sunday. We have a lot of activity groups that mainly cater to the regulars. We are doing okay; we are on cruise control here. We have great worship. Sounds good, doesn't it? And the Lord says, "I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew thee out of my mouth. Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:" (Revelation 3:15-17)

Or take the Israelites on their journey to the Promised Land. Moses tells the people of the goodness and prosperity that awaits them, but also to beware of a spiritual complacency that would follow their prosperity. "When you have had children and children's children, and become complacent in the land, if you act corruptly by making an idol in the form of anything, thus doing what is evil in the sight of the Lord your God, and provoking him to anger, I call heaven and earth to witness against you today that you will soon utterly perish from the land that you are crossing the Jordan to occupy; you will not live long on it, but will be utterly destroyed." (Deut. 4:25-26 NRSV)

Yes, success is a blessing from God for our hard work, but we're not done yet. Yes, we have a good church, but we can have a better one. Yes, we have a good number of saved souls in our congregation, but Pitt county has almost 200,000 unsaved souls. Yes, we have great services, but have we confined (or defined) ourselves within these four walls? Let's get a fresh burden for the lost. Jesus told us "As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work." (John 9:4 NIV) -wm

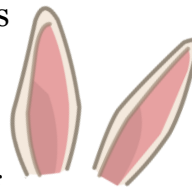
