Memorial Day Trivia!

-Memorial Day is a day on which those who died in active military service are remembered.

-Traditionally observed on May 30 but now officially observed on the last Monday in May.

-It originated during the American Civil War (Decoration Day) when citizens placed flowers on the graves of those who had been killed in battle.

-In 1971, Memorial Day was established as a federal holiday.

-Many Americans mark Memorial Day with an official moment of remembrance at 3pm local time.

-During the 3 p.m. moment of remembrance on Memorial Day, Amtrak conductors sound one long whistle in honor of those who have died in service.

-New York was the first state to recognize Memorial Day as an official holiday in 1873.

-Red poppies have become a symbol of Memorial Day because they are mentioned in a 1915 poem "In Flanders Fields."
