-The Liberty Bell in Philadelphia is tapped 13 times every July 4th in honor of the original 13 colonies.

-John Adams and Thomas Jefferson both died on July 4, 1826.
James Monroe died July 4, 1831.

-Calvin Coolidge is the only president that was born on the 4th of July (1872).

-Edward Rutledge was the youngest person to sign the Declaration of Independence at 26 years old, while Benjamin Franklin was the oldest at 70 years old.

-John Hancock was the first person to sign the Declaration of Independence on August 2, 1776. His signature was also the largest.

-"The Star-Spangled Banner" was made the national anthem by a congressional resolution on March 3, 1931 and signed by President Herbert Hoover.

-56 delegates signed the Declaration of Independence.

-Three North Carolinians signed the Declaration of Independence: William Hooper, Joseph Hewes, and John Penn.
