Why Should We Pray?

- **God commands us to pray.** “Pray without ceasing.” (1 Thessalonians 5:17) “After this manner, therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.” (Matthew 6:9)
- **To give thanks to God.** “In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.” (1 Thessalonians 5:18) “Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.” (Philippians 4:6) “Give thanks unto the Lord, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people.” (1 Chronicles 16:8)
- **To praise God.** “By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to his name.” (Hebrews 13:15) “I will bless the Lord at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth.” (Psalm 34:1)
- **For divine protection.** “Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I. For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.” (Psalm 61:1-3) “But thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head. I cried unto the Lord with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah. I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the Lord sustained me. I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set themselves against me round about.” (Psalm 3:3-6)
- **For mercy.** “Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.” (Hebrews 4:16) “Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.” (Psalm 4:1)
- **For provision.** “Give us this day our daily bread.” (Matthew 6:11) “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened.” (Matthew 7:7) “The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.” (Psalm 23:1) “The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing.” (Psalm 34:10)
- **It strengthens us.** “But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” (Isaiah 40:31) “Seek the Lord and his strength, seek his face continually.” (1 Chron. 16:11)
- **It helps to overcome sin.** “Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.” (Matthew 26:41) “Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil...Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.” (Ephesians 6:11, 18)
- **For forgiveness.** “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” (1 John 1:9) “And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.” (Matthew 6:12)
- **For healing.** “And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he hath committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.” (James 5:15) “O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.” (Psalm 30:2)
