

Need to Build up your Faith? Part 2

Noah... "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith." (Hebrews 11:7) No modern day tools, no machinery, no hired workers. Just

Noah, just his family, just his faith in God and believing that God would do what He said He would do. The ungodly people around Noah laughed at this "crazy man." But in spite of the unbelief of the world around him, Noah believed and was saved.

Paul and Silas... "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed." (Acts 16:25-26) These two men were thrown into the inner prison, had there feet



chained, and were beaten. In this dire situation, many would give up; many would give up on God. So what did Paul and Silas do? They praised God. They prayed. They sang hymns. And they sang loud, so loud that all the prisoners heard them. And God did a miracle, sending an earthquake to free them all. In your bad times, don't give up on God! Pray! Worship! Keep believing!

The centurion's servant... "And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him... When Jesus heard it, he marveled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel... Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour." (Matthew 8:5-7, 10, 13) The Roman centurion, a Gentile, was in authority of a group of soldiers. But he came to Jesus with faith, with humility, and put himself under the authority of Jesus. This is faith, believing in something even though it hasn't happened or come true yet. And this centurion had more faith that those in Jesus' home town. Another show of faith; another show of the miraculous!
