Fourth of July Trivia!

- Calvin Coolidge was the first and only president to have been born of the Fourth of July. Three presidents have died on July 4 (John Adams, Thomas Jefferson, and James Monroe).
- In 2022, Americans spent \$2.3 billion on fireworks.
- Americans eat about 155 million hot dogs each Fourth of July, enough to stretch from D.C. to L.A. more than five times.
- The Liberty Bell rings 13 times on July 4.
- 56 people signed the Declaration of Independence.
- Around 64% of Americans own a U.S.A. flag.
- Six American flags have made it to the moon (Apollo 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, and 17 missions).
- The 50th star was added to the American flag on July 4, 1960 (for the state of Hawaii).
